Home-School Agreement 2019-2020

The aim of Gilnow Primary School is to ensure that pupils do their best in all aspects of school life and are well prepared to meet the challenges of the future.

Pupils achieve their best when teachers and parents support each other in partnership.

In partnership, parents expect the school to:

- Be open, welcoming and supportive of parents, visitors and members of the local community;
- Provide a safe, orderly and caring school environment;
- Provide a curriculum and teaching that will enable each child to achieve their best;
- Encourage personal and social development, respect and self-discipline;
- Provide a friend for the new child through a buddy system;
- Issue regular information about progress and achievement and early warning of problems.

In partnership, the school expects parents to:

- Ensure children attend school regularly and on time, whenever possible, taking appointments out of school time;
- Provide documents if your child has to attend any appointment, eg dentist, doctor during school time;
- Any travel arrangements must be arranged with school before anything is booked;
- Ensure children are in school uniform, with haircuts ensure there are no lines, symbols or layers, T-shirt will be required for Art and Design;
- Ensure the correct PE kits are brought into school;
- Take an interest in progress, homework and activities and attend parent's evenings;
- Ensure my child only uses age appropriate apps, websites and social media;
- Support the values, rewards and sanctions as part of our school's code of conduct;
- Make staff aware of any concerns or problems that may affect the child's life at Gilnow School;
- Understand my child will take part in singing, dancing and swimming activities, it is compulsory and part of our school curriculum;
- Understand we do not allow fasting at Gilnow. Year 6 can apply to the Headteacher in writing;
- Understand my child will be expected to attend school on Eid at the start of day;
- Understand that if my child feels they are being bullied I should contact the school at any time and ask to speak to a member of staff I feel comfortable speak to;
- Not use mobile phones on site and refrain from making any comments regarding our School on Social Media.

In partnership, the school and parents expect each child to:

- Arrive at school on time every day;
- Bring everything to school that they need for the day;
- Listen to, and follow the school rules at all times;
- Follow the teacher's instructions the first time;
- To use age appropriate apps, websites and social media;
- Work as hard as possible at all times;
- To co-operate with the schools buddy system;
- Tell an adult as soon as possible if something has upset them.

I understand that school may need to share data with my GP regarding my child when it is requested, I understand I have the right to request the data supplied or processed at any time.
